The use of JSF frameworks have gained momentum in recent times, since they facilitate and optimize time in software development, including BootsFaces, a framework Front-End developed in 2013, is responsive because it contains Jquery, Bootstrap and Ajax that fuses easily with PrimeFaces achieving striking and interactive interfaces with the end user, the combination of tags of these frameworks meet the needs of certain programmers, since it does not present any interference between them and the design environment is almost similar to PrimeFaces.

Once seen its advantages of these frameworks and their favorable fusion has proceeded to develop the web system under this modality, first has been considered the geographical location of the subjuncts that integrate it, and has developed an adaptable application since they do not have computers or sites with internet.

# II. PROBLEM

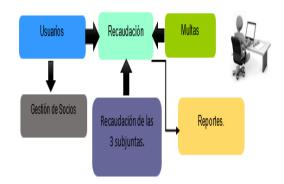


Figure 1: Block diagram of the application.

The ManagerDAO handles the communication to the BDD, the ManagerEJB handles all the application business logic.

**Controller:** JSF uses well formed Beans and allows us to connect the interface with the applicative logic.

**View:** In the projects of JSF, the WebContent folder is a container for resources for the design of the user interface. The WEB-INF subfolder is fundamental for accommodation additional libraries.

#### VI. METHODOLOGY

For this thesis project has been used XP (EXtreme Programming) methodology, since it proposes a set of best practices and techniques that emphasize positive effects in a software development project.

This methodology is based on communication, simplicity, feedback, respect and courage. And it makes use of user stories, these are the description of key scenarios of the operation of the software, it is carried out between the client and the team representative. From them, the releases are generated that allow defining the iterations necessary to fulfill the objectives.

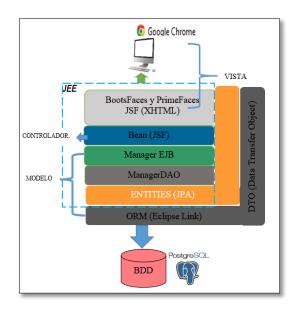
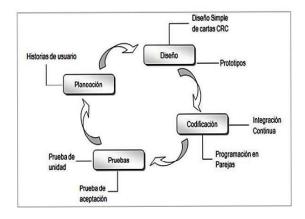


Figure 2: Architecture of the system.
