Displays information for decision- making by the administrative staff of the company


5. APPLICATIONS RIA

5.1. Architecture






The RIA Aplications (Rich Internet Application) are increasingly developed by software companies, and that can offer a better user experience.

Microsoft Silverlight is a web browser plugin based on the Windows platform that adds new multimedia features like playing videos, vector graphics, animation and development environment; similarly to what makes Adobe Flash. Silverlight supports different platforms and web browsers.

- Hardware acceleration is enabled in windowless mode with Internet Explorer 9.


6.2. Architecture Silverlight

Silverlight provides several useful controls for displaying information and manipulation of input data




6.4. Model Applications




7. DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

XP is based on continuous feedback between the client and the development team, communication between all participants in the solutions implemented simplicity and courage to face the changes. XP is defined as especially suitable for projects with very vague and changing requirements, and where there is a high technical risk

User stories are the technique used in XP to specify the functionality of the system from the point of view of the customer. It is paper cards in which the client briefly describes the features that the system must possess, whether functional or non-functional requirements



- The XP methodology allows small workgroups (2), shorter development times, development projects, objectoriented; currently one of the most accepted methodologies for software development projects, while other methods require detailed documentation processes generating more extensive development time.
